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3.	I received from the Association's manager a true and correct list of the
Association's	members, including their last known mailing addresses, for the purpose of
providing noti	ce of the hearing on the "Verified Petition for Order Reducing Percentage of
Votes Necessary to Amend the Bylaws of a Common Interest Development and for an Order	
Approving the	e Amendment" ("Petition"). Each member on the mailing list was provided
notice of the h	earing on the Petition as set forth in the Declaration of Mailing filed herewith.

- 4. The Association is seeking to amend the Bylaws to bring it up to date with current law, especially the 2014 revisions to the Davis-Stirling Common Interest Development Act (Cal. Civ. Code §§ 4000-6150). The Board also addressed certain issues that became apparent after the community was developed that were not contemplated by the developer when the Bylaws were originally drafted. The Board's goal was to revise the Bylaws so they better address the needs of the community, to make the Bylaws more user friendly, and to make them comply with the changes in the law.
- 5. The declarant (developer) no longer holds any interest in the Association, and there is no requirement that the Association notify any lender or mortgagee of the hearing on the petition. Nor is there any requirement that the Association notify the city and/or county in which this Association is located.
